### **CIRCULAR No. 06**

Ref : This Office Circular No. 05 dtd. 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2010.

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to the above circular with an enclosure of Notification (corrigendum) No. DSYA/STATE SPORTS POLICY/GOA/2009/3432 dated 09/04/2010 now the modalities of adding Sports Merit Marks are being circulated as herebelow :-

#### **(A) For Stds. X and XII S.S.C. and H.S.S.C. Examinations**

1. The allotment of Sports Merit marks would be as per Table in the Corrigendum as stated above. Highest level of participation and performance in any one event is to be considered for award of Sports Merit Marks, if the students are performing in more than one level/event.
2. In the case of those students who are passing, Sports Merit Marks will be shown separately in the marksheet.
3. In the case of those students who are failing, Sports Merit Marks will be added to those subject/s in which they have failed, either theory or practicals or both, which will be indicated by asterisk mark (\*), after which condonation marks will be added and this will be indicated by a plus sign (+). The balance of Sports Merit Marks, if any, will be shown separately in the marksheet.
4. Some students despite adding the Sports Merit Marks as well as the condonation marks, they are not able to pass. In this case the Sports Merit Marks will be shown separately in the marksheet.
5. The certificates for Sports participation/achievement have to be authenticated either by Directorate of Sports & Youth Affairs or Sports Authority of Goa. The parents should do the needful and submit the same to the Goa Board by 30-4-2010.
6. In case a student has failed in the SSC/HSSC Examinations and appears again, Sports Merit Marks due to him/her as a sports student shall be carried forward in subsequent examinations.

(B) **For Stds. VIII, IX and XI**

1. The allotment of Sports Merit Marks would be as per Table in the Corrigendum as stated above. Highest level of participation and performance in any one event is to be considered for award of Sports Merit Marks, if the students are performing in more than one level/event.
2. In the case of those who are passing on their own merit, Sports Merit Marks shall be shown separately in the report card.
1. In the case of those students who are failing, Sports Merit Marks will have to be added in those subjects in which they are failing and then the grades will have to be determined. This will be indicated by an asterisk mark (\*) against the Grade in the subject/s where the Sports Merit Marks have been added. The balance of Sports Merit Marks, if any, are to be shown separately in the report card.
2. In case of students failing even after adding Sports Merit Marks and determining the grades, the Sports Merit marks shall be shown separately in the report card.
3. In case a sports student has acquired an aggregate of more than 100%, it shall be treated as 100%.
4. If a student has participated in sports in the summer vacation preceding the Academic Year this should be counted/considered for the award of Sports Merit Marks for the ensuing academic year.

(C) **For Stds. VIII and IX**

In case a student is failing, the Sports Merit Marks has to be added to the average of either theory or practicals or both and the grades have to be determined.

The Certificates for Sports participation/achievement have to be endorsed either by Dy. Director of Sports & Youth Affairs or the Executive Director of Sports Authority of Goa. The Heads of Schools (for Stds. V – IX and XI) should do the needful and prepare the results of the sports children accordingly. For this year (2009 – 10) they should first declare the results of those students not covered under State Sports Policy 2009 as scheduled and then declare the results of those benefiting from the State Sports Policy, after obtaining the requisite authenticated certificates.
