Sub.:- ATKT for students failing in two subjects at S.S.C. Examination.

Sir/Madam,

As per existing Rules, a student failing in one subject and passing in the remaining five subjects at the S.S.C. Examination, with an average of 40% in the five subjects in which the student has passed, is allowed to keep terms in Std. XIth and that student can clear the sixth subject in which he/she has failed by answering the subject in subsequent S. S. C. Examination/s.

Now the Board has decided that the concession of ATKT so far allowed to students failing in only one subject as stated above be extended to those who may fail in two subjects and pass in remaining four subjects with aggregate of 40% marks in those four subjects.

Such students shall have to clear the failed subjects by appearing in S. S. C. Examination held subsequently.

Results of Std. XIth of such students admitted with ATKT shall not be declared nor shall they be admitted in Std. XIIth unless they clear both the failed subjects of S. S. C. E.

The above provision will come in force with effect from the S. S. C. Examination held in March/April 2010.
