Sub:- Grant of A.T.K.T. and exemption for theory & practical separately.

Sir/Madam,

1. The decision to grant A.T.K.T. to students appearing for S.S.C. Examination and failing in two subjects was communicated by above referred circular to all the Secondary & Higher Secondary Institution recognized by this Board.

Now that Board has decided to adopt grading system the matter of grant of A.T.K.T. concession was reviewed in term of grading system and it is decided as below: -

- Case no 1** - Grade of 'A' to 'G' in five subjects and grade 'I' in one subject for A.T.K.T. in one Subject provided the candidate secures a grade value of 20 in the 5 subjects in which the candidate has qualified.
- Case no 2** - Grade of 'A' to 'G's in four subjects and grade of two 'H' for A.T.K.T. in one subject. In this case, the candidate may select the subject of his/her choice to answer A.T.K.T. provided the candidates secures a grade value of 20 in the five subjects in which the candidate has qualified (including the subject in which the candidate has secured a 'H' grade).
- Case no 3** - Grade of 'A' to 'G' in four subjects and grade of two 'I' for A.T.K.T. in two subjects provided the candidate secures a grade value of 16 in the four subjects in which the candidate has qualified.
- Case no 4** - Grade of 'A' to 'G' in four subjects, a grade of 'H' in one subject and grade of 'I' in the remaining subject for A.T.K.T. in one subject where the student has been awarded 'I' grade provided the candidate secures a grade value of 20 in the remaining five subjects (including the subject in which the candidate has secured a 'H' grade).

Note: (i) To qualify in the subject in the subsequent Examination/s, candidates with A.T.K.T./s will have to secure a grade from 'A' to 'G' only.

(ii) The internal assessment component/s may be carried forward for subsequent Examinations in case of candidate/s attempting to clear A.T.K.T.

2. It is to further inform that in the subjects involving practicals, the Board has decided to grant exemption separately for practical and theory components so that the candidate will be required to appear only in the component in which the candidates has not qualified and needs improvement. This concession will be enforced from the S.S.C. & H.S.S.C. Examination of March/April 2011 and onwards.
