Sub:- Revised Pattern of Grading for Std IX and XI with effect from 2011-2012 onwards

Sir/Madam,

The following Nine-point scale for Absolute Grading shall be used in all subjects, both academic as well as School Assessment subjects with effect from current Academic year 2011-2012 onwards.

Grades are to be awarded separately for Theory and Year Round Assessment (YRA) components, and overall after adding theory and YRA components based on the percentage scored as shown in Table No.1 above.

For passing a subject a student will have to secure any grade from A to G in that subject provided he/she secures minimum H grade separately in Theory and Year Round Assessment

Theory : Unit tests/Mid term and First & Second/Final Terminal Examinations.

Year Round Work : Orals, Practicals, assignments/projects, year's work, Class response & note book.

A student who secures 'I' grade either in Theory or Year Round Assessment separately in a subject will necessarily be awarded 'I' grade overall in that subject.

A student for qualifying for next higher class will have to secure a grade from A to G grade in all six subjects.

A student failing to secure A to G grade in the School Assessment Subject/s will be given enough opportunity by the Head of the Institution to improve his/her grade in such subject/s, before the declaration of Final results.

A student is entitled for maximum six condonation marks for obtaining overall 'G' Grade in one or more subject/s after adding the Theory and YRA components.

A student declared as "Need improvement" and securing overall 'H' or 'T' grade in one or two subjects will be eligible to appear for supplementary examination in one/two subjects only to be conducted not earlier than one month after declaration of final results and not later than 2nd week of commencement of next academic year and for which the portion will be the whole year's portion. Student may be exempted from Theory or YRA component for which he/she has qualified.

A specimen of final report card for Std IX is shown in Annexure – I and for Std XI in Annexure - II

It is further informed that ATKT to students of Std XI be allowed only for the current academic year 2011-12. From the next academic year 2012-13 students of Std XI may be permitted to answer supplementary examination in upto 2 subjects in which he/she secures 'H' or 'T' grade.

The contents of this circular is to be brought to the notice of all concerned, including the parents of candidates appearing for March/April 2012 for Std IX and XI.

This circular supercedes all other circulars issued in this regard.

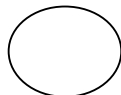

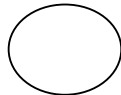

In the Grading Scheme for Std X Public Examination for the year 2011-2012 enclosed with the above mentioned circular, the following are to be noted:-

- 1) On page 03 for Table No.2 asterisk sign (*) is to be inserted after 2 ½ hrs for 2nd Terminal Examination for non practical subjects also indicating inclusion of core content for 2nd terminal Examination.
- 2) On page 04 for Table No3 for duration of science practicals “2 ½ hrs” should be read as “1hr”
- 3) On page 05 at Sr.no.5 in the penultimate (second last) line “five point” should read as “blue print”.
- 4) In Annexure V A the word “Assignment” is to be deleted.

It is further to clarify that: -

- i) For the final S.S.C. Examination Social Science I and Social Science II question papers will each be of 40 marks and 1 ½ hour duration.
- ii) The marks for Social Science I and Social Science II have to be sent combined for the First Terminal and Second Terminal Examination, as shown in Annexure II and III A.
- iii) The Grading Scheme and Annexure for pre-vocational subjects for internal Examination of class X will be sent shortly.
