**CIRCULAR NO: 16**

To,

The Heads of all recognized  
Higher Secondary Schools  
within the jurisdiction of this Board.

Sir,

1. All the heads of Higher Secondary Schools offering CRM/B&C/Tourism based Vocational Courses are hereby informed that the students opting for above mentioned courses should mandatorily undergo IRT (Industrial Release Training) as part of their curriculum in Std. XI immediately after the completion of the 1<sup>st</sup> terminal Examination in reputed hotels viz. 5 star/3 star/boutique hotels for a min. period of 2 months. This particular period is chosen as its peak season time & provides ample opportunity to the students to gain basic grounding & sharpening their skill which cannot be developed in the school. The main objective of the said training is to produce globally acceptable competent technical manpower and to acclimatize the students with the changing needs of the industry and make up for the lacunas existing in the school environment. This training shall be considered as OJT. Students who do not satisfactorily complete the IRT, will not be permitted to answer the 2<sup>nd</sup> term examination.

The Principals are requested to strictly adhere to this circular & maintain records of the said training which are subject to inspection by the Board from time to time.

2. The Academic Council of the Board has approved the revised syllabus, Instructional Materials, New pattern Model question paper, Blue Prints and Curriculum for Catering and Restaurant Management Course and Travel & Tourism Course at Higher Secondary level in following subjects:

**Catering and Restaurant Management Course**

- a) Food & Beverages Service for class XI (Theory & Practical)
- b) Food Production for class XI (Theory & Practical)
- c) Bakery & Patisserie for class XI (Theory & Practical)
- d) Accommodation Operators for class XI (Theory & Practical)

**Tourism Course**

- a) Travel Geography for class XI (Theory & Practical)

**Bakery & Confectionery Course**

- a) Confectionery for class XI (Theory & Practical)

The revised changes that were proposed will be applicable from the next academic year 2016-2017.

Further to the distribution of grant for improvement of infrastructure to the existing CRM/Bakery & Confectionery practical labs, it has been decided to conduct inspection of schools to check the available facilities for conduct of Practicals
