CORRIGENDUM

Read:-Circular No.07 and Circular No.08 dtd. 12th April 2016

Sub: Revised Pattern of Assessment/Grading for class. IX and class XI.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the above cited subject, a corrigendum is issued in order to clarify above mentioned Circulars.

The contents of this are to be brought to the notice of all concerned.

Criteria for passing

1. A student should secure minimum of 33 % (G grade) with 21% (H grade) separately in each component i.e. Theory 21% and Practical / YRA- 21 %
2. A student is eligible for condonation marks in one or all subjects provided he/she obtains overall G grade in all subjects after adding theory and practical.
3. Condonation marks should however not be considered for making a student eligible to appear for supplementary exam.

Regarding Sports merit marks

1. In case a student has sports merit marks he/she should secure minimum of 11 % in theory and 11 % in Practical / YRA, provided he/she secures minimum H grade in theory and practical after availing sports merit marks and clear the exam by availing Sports Merit Marks.
2. A student after availing sports merit marks is eligible for condonation marks provided he/she secures overall G grade in all subjects after availing condonation marks.

Regarding Supplementary exam

1. For std. XI, the supplementary examination of 80 marks will be of 2 1/2 hr. duration for non practical subjects and 55 marks for 2 1/2 hr. duration for practical subjects. Std. IX examination will be conducted of 80 marks for 2 1/2 hr. duration and 65 marks for 2 1/2 hr. duration.
2. The supplementary exam will be based on 60 % of Second term portion and 40 % of First term portion.
3. The student is entitled for the condonation and Sports merit marks since he/she has not availed this facility in the main examination.
4. A student shall be promoted to std. XIIth only if he/she passes the Supplementary examination with 33 % (G grade) aggregate (theory and previous practical/YRA marks).
5. If a student is absent on medical grounds he/she should be given another opportunity.
