- * The word 'Subject' is to be written in full. The subject topic is to be written briefly.
- * Letter content in 3 paragraphs. (Introduction., Body/Main paragraph, Conclusion)
- * Thank you. (not 'thanking you')
- * Accept' Yours sincerely/truly'
- * Signature thus: e.g. P. Naik. No fancy signature. Full name written below signature may be in small or capital letters. Praful Naik or PRAFUL NAIK .No spacing to be left between signature and full name.
- * Equal spacing is a must between all items in letter. (single spacing)
- * Punctuation marks only within addresses and content.
- * Expression includes tone, grammatical accuracy, spellings, and organization of ideas including suggestions if asked for.
- * 01 mark to be given if Question is attempted, however briefly.
